

Barberton Youth Football & Cheerleading Player Code of Conduct & Zero Tolerance Policy

1. I will not use curse words while at any Barberton Youth Football activities. If I am heard using curse words, I will have to run laps at practice. If I continue to use curse words, I will be suspended for 1 game.
2. I will not use violence of any kind towards another person while at any Barberton Youth Football activities. If I use violence, I will have to run laps at practice. If I continue to use violence, I will be suspended for 1 game. Repeated use of violence will cause me to be kicked off of the football team.
3. I will not participate in any form of bullying toward another person during any Barberton Youth Football activities. This will cause a punishment to be determined by the director.
4. If I have a problem with a coach, I will wait 24 hours or until the next practice/ game before speaking with the coach about it. If I cannot wait, I will speak to the Director or Assistant Director first.
5. I understand that all the coaches/directors/volunteers do this for free on their own time and will show them respect while speaking to them.
6. I understand if I pull myself out of a game or refuse to play, I will owe running laps to my coach at the next practice. If I pull myself out of a game or refuse to play on more than one occasion, I will lose my position on my team if it is a varsity or starting position.

Barberton Youth Football & Cheerleading Parent Code of Conduct & Zero Tolerance Policy

1. I will not use curse words while at any Barberton Youth Football activities. This will cause an immediate 2 game ban from Barberton Youth Football activities.
2. I will not use violence of any kind towards another person while at any Barberton Youth Football activities. This will cause an immediate ban from Barberton Youth Football.
3. I will not threaten any form of violence to another person during any Barberton Youth Football activities. This will cause an immediate ban from Barberton Youth Football activities.
4. If I have a problem with a coach, I will wait 24 hours or until the next practice/ game before speaking with the coach about it. If I cannot wait, I will speak to the Director or Assistant Director first.
5. I understand that all the coaches/directors/volunteers do this for free on their own time and will show them respect while speaking to them about my child.
6. I understand that a coach will not force my child to play in a game if they refuse to play. Forcing a child into a game they are refusing to play may cause an injury to the child or another player.
7. I understand my child is expected to be at all practices. If my child needs to miss, I will report his/her absence to the HEAD COACH prior to the start of practice. My failure to report my child's absence will result in my child running laps at practice. Due to safety concerns, two unexcused absences in one week will result in my child forfeiting playing time for half a game. Three or more absences in a week will result in my child forfeiting playing time for an entire game.
